**CHÂTEAU DU GLANA 2009****Wine Spectator: 90 /100**

Sleek, with good winery currant, blackberry and graphite notes and a long, anise-tinged finish. Not big, but pure and racy. Best from 2013 through 2020. JM - March 2012

Tasted: 92,5/100

AL – Elegant nose, mineral with stony notes, blackcurrant and fine spices, the wine has a very elegant, classic and firmly built structure yet with good notion of ripeness and juicy fruit with layers of fine tannins, elegant fruit and a very persistent aftertaste, very clean and stylish with brilliant potential.

MdM- Dark purple red with violet hue and almost black centre. Nose with elegant spicy notes, liquorice and ripe fruit. On the palate clean and well balanced with tight structure and firm tannins as well as good length. #4 / April 2012

Jane Anson: 93+ /100

Owned by M. Meffre, now working with his sons Ludovic and Julien, with Denis Dubourdieu as consultant. Rich, glass-staining purple colour. Well extracted tannins. They hold you tight, and I am waiting for them to kick in and dry out, but they don't. This is a big wine, very meaty, but it delivers with lovely fresh fruit.
